Program Focus:

- Provide hands-on warehouse and logistics training from specialized personnel
- Provide assistance with soft skills, resume building and job placement
- Provide interview and job readiness training
- Provide employment assistance

Eligibility Requirements

- Desire to work, or have a career in the logistics/warehouse field
- Commitment to a 10-week program without interruption
- Childcare established prior to enrollment
- Must be 18 years or older and have current state ID
- Able to read and write at an 8th grade level
- Physical ability to perform duties (standing, lifting, operating material handling equipment)
- Ability to lift a minimum of 50 lbs.
- Pass drug screen at start of program and prior to employment
- Comprehensive background check will be completed prior to entry

Program Specifics:

- 10 week program (Monday – Thursday 8:15 AM – 3:00 PM; Friday 8:15AM – 12:00 PM)
- Gateway Community & Technical College and Freestore Foodbank
- (specific pick-up locations and bus passes provided)
- Graduates have the opportunity to earn:

1. *Powered Industrial Equipment License (PIT)*
2. *Certified Logistics Associate (CLA) (passing grade required)*
3. *Certified Logistics Technician (CLT) (passing grade required)*
4. *ServSafe Food Handler Certificate*
5. *Certificate of Completion from LIFT the TriState Program*

LIFT students are eligible to earn up to 6 credit hours through Gateway College program. If a student passes the Certified Logistics Associate (CLA) and/or Certified Logistics Technician (CLT) -- students may receive 3 credit hours through Gateway College for each certificate.
